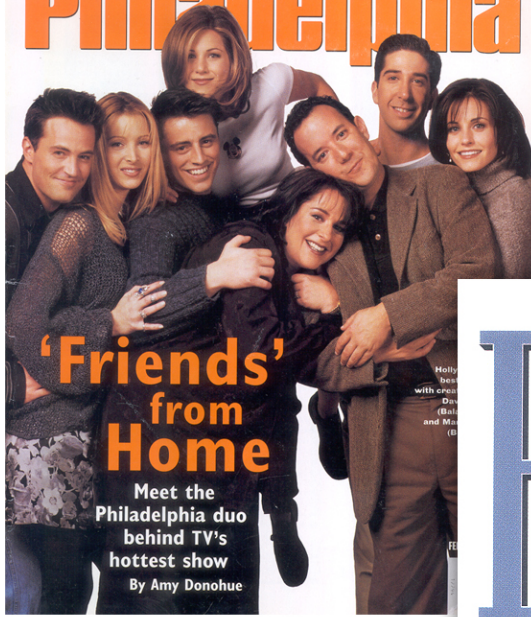

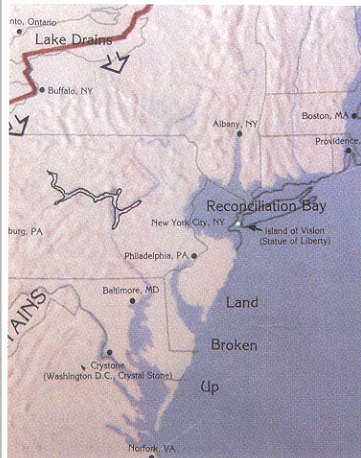

publish the *I Am America* map (left). It shows what Philadelphia could look like in as little as 14 years—if much-prophe- sied earth changes aren't lessened by a collective change of heart. When we choose "brotherly love," say the Toyes, the infusion of positive energy starts to dissolve a centuries-old buildup of negativity hovering over the East Coast. "We're already seeing hurricanes, floods, erratic temperatures— they're the minor warning changes."
